Mateusz Wolski was born in Warsaw, Poland where he began his musical training at the age of seven. He studied at the Szymanowski Musical High School and the Chopin Music Academy in Warsaw before traveling to the U.S. to attend Manhattan School of Music. It was there, with full scholarship, that he completed his bachelor's and master's degrees under the tutelage of New York Philharmonic Concertmaster Glenn Dicterow.

Mateusz has enjoyed a distinguished solo career both in the U.S. and abroad.

As an orchestral musician, he has played with New York Philharmonic in over 200 concerts and four international tours, as well as with the Baltimore Symphony Orchestra and National Philharmonic.

Mateusz has recorded for dozens of movie soundtracks and performs on a violin owned by the Spokane Symphony that was crafted by Italian master Carlo Landolfi in 1779.
